

Table planner

Our dining space is incredibly versatile accommodating both small and large weddings.

Here are our most popular table layouts using rectangular or round tables - or both. The table plans below can be used in conjunction with various online wedding planning tools to design your seating plans.




RECTANGULAR TABLES

- 4ft x 2ft6" rectangular tables
- Top table seats 10 people on average
- Rows can be in sets of 3 tables (seating 12) or 4 (seating 16) up to a maximum of 9 rows
- Seat two people either side
- Table top to the floor is 2ft 5.5 inches

We have three different configurations for the carpeted dining area using our rectangular dining tables:

Rectangular Plan 1 - Top Table


Seats from 50 to 154 guests





Rectangular Plan 2 – Parallel Tables

Seats from 50 up to 144 people








Rectangular Plan 3 – Triples

Seats from 50 up to 144 people






ROUND TABLES

Seats from 50 up to 112 people (on carpeted area only - see below for weddings with larger numbers)

- 12 x 6ft round tables
- Each round table seats 12 quests
- Top table seats at max of 10 quests

Round Plan 1 – Just Rounds


Seats from 50 up to 110 people.





Rounds 2 – Rounds with Top Table

Seats from 50 up to 130 people.








Round Plan 3 – Rounds in two spaces

Seats up to 228 people

Large archways allow the dining room and dance floor to flow into one. Use round tables in both spaces (extra round tables will need to be hired in for weddings above 200 guests)






Round/Rectangular – combination

Seats up to 250 people

Use rectangular tables in carpeted dining area and round tables on dancefloor
