




### THE VENUE

Aswanley lies on the banks of the River Deveron on the edge of the Grampian Mountains in Aberdeenshire.





### RENEWABLE ENERGY



Aswanley values sustainability and environmental stewardship across the farm. Renewable energy heats the entirety of Aswanley Steading and house, here's how:

Timber from the surrounding farm is seasoned for at least 18 months and used to fuel the biomass boiler which is tucked away at Aswanley and generates heat to keep you and your guests cosy.

Hydro power is one of the most efficient and reliable renewable energy sources. We utilise the flowing water in the burn running past Aswanley and into the River Deveron to generate electricity for the venue and house.

The power of the sun is captured through an array of solar panels hidden away in the valleys of the steading roof. By converting sunlight into electricity we further reduce our carbon footprint.

### HOW TO GET HERE

Aswanley is conveniently situated halfway between Aberdeen and Inverness and just five minutes from the A96. Dufftown, the home of Glenfiddich whisky, is an easy 8 miles away on the edge of the Grampian mountains.






